It's officially spring and April means that Easter and Holy Week are right around the corner. We will kick off Holy Week with Palm Sunday on April 13th. On Thursday of that week, we will

have a come and go prayer service where you can come and receive communion between 5:00-7:00pm. On good Friday, we will have our traditional service of the Tenebrae at 7pm in the sanctuary. Easter Sunday is April 20th and we will have potluck brunch at 9:30am, where you can learn about how to get more involved in the life of the church, and our Combined Easter service at 11am. I hope you will join us in the celebration of our risen Lord!

Our current sermon series is "At the feet of the Master," a six-week series that will take us right up to Easter Sunday. What sets followers of Jesus apart from the rest of the world? We will look at Jesus' sermon on the mount to find the answers.

Our Wednesday night Bible Study is starting a new study "The Epic of David." Where we will study one of the more fascinating characters in all of the Old Testament. This study will last 10 weeks and take us right up to our summer break at the end of May. Be sure to join us every Wednesday night at 6pm in the celebration classroom.

During Lent we will continue our Lenten lunches every Tuesday from noon to one pm. I have invited the various faith communities and their pastors to join us in an ecumenical hour of food, worship, and message to help us prepare for Easter. If you are available for lunch during Lent, I highly recommend that you attend.

There is a lot going on in the life of the church these days, I hope that you will join me in celebrating this sacred time on the Christian calendar. We are an Easter people living into the promise of resurrection and new life.


