After a long winter we are finally starting to see the first glimpses of Spring on the horizon. Hopefully the recent cold snap represents the final remnants of a winter that is giving way to the

new warmer season of life.

It's a busy time of the year for the Christian calendar, March 5<sup>th</sup> is Ash Wednesday, and we will kick off the season of Lent with our traditional pancake supper in Joy Hall at 5:00pm followed by our Ash Wednesday service in the sanctuary at 6pm. Lent is the time where Christians have historically prepared for Easter by observing forty days of adding on or taking away something from our daily life in order to reorient our hearts on Christ in preparation for Easter Sunday.

Our Lent sermon series is "At the feet of the Master," a five-week series that will take us right up to Easter Sunday. What sets followers of Jesus apart from the rest of the world? We will look at Jesus' sermon on the mount to find the answers.

Our Wednesday night Bible Study is continuing to walk through the Gospel of Matthew, how does Matthew offer a unique perspective on the life and ministry of Jesus Christ? After we finish the Gospel of Matthew, we will study one of the more satisfying characters in all of the Old Testament. During Lent we will resume our Lenten lunches every Tuesday (more information inside) from noon to one pm. I have invited the various faith communities and their pastors to join us in an ecumenical hour of food, worship, and message to help us prepare for Easter. If you are available for lunch during Lent, I highly recommend that you attend.

There is a lot going on in the life of the church these days, I hope that you will join me in celebrating this sacred time on the Christian calendar.

We are an Easter people living into the promise of resurrection and new life. Because of the cross we know that death does not have the final say in this world!




## **Beginner Line Dance Class**


